# Nordic Junior Shooting Championship

August 25<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> 2010

Vierumäki-Heinola, Hälvälä-Hollola

Finland

The Finnish Shooting Sport Federation in co-operation with Sport Institute of Finland and Lahti Shooting Sport Club has the honour to invite all member federations of the Nordic Shooting Region, Estonia and Ireland to participate in the Nordic Junior Shooting Championships in Pistol, Rifle, Shotgun and Running Target. The Championships will be organised August 25<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> 2010 in Vierumäki Arena Heinola and Hälvälä Shooting Center Hollola.

Base for the Championships will be in Lahti Region, near by city Lahti and Heinola. It take about 70 min from Helsinki International Airport.

Nearly all disciplines in Pistol, Rifle and Running Target will take place at Vierumäki Shooting Arena (shooting will happen indoor).

All shotgun and RT 50m events will be at Hälvälä Shooting Center (Range where the 2002 World Championships were organised).

### Accommodation

We have made accommodation reservations for all Nationals Teams, Jury Members and also for accompanys from the area of Sport Institute. Nearest, the new Scandic Vierumäki hotel is located only 150 m from shooting arena, hotel Ilkka and Country Club about 300-500m from Arena. Preliminary booking of hotel rooms for National Teams and Jury members will be done based on information in Entry Form A **not later than 15<sup>th</sup> June 2010**.

**Final booking of accommodation for will be done in Entry Form B not later than 15<sup>th</sup> July 2010.**

#### Scandic Hotel Vierumäki

Price: Single rooms 129 Euro per person including breakfast.  
Double rooms 75 Euro per person and night including breakfast.

#### Hotel Ilkka and Country Club

Price: Single room 113 Euro per night including half board (breakfast and dinner)  
Double rooms 80 Euro per person and night including half board (breakfast and dinner).

Accompanying guests that needs accommodation at the hotels mentioned above must make reservations through the organising committee. **All reservations must be done at the latest 15<sup>th</sup> July**, after this date we can only make reservations if rooms are available. **Reservations are**

**binding and all payments** for rooms must be paid in advance to the organization committee after our confirming of the reservation, **at the latest July 31<sup>st</sup>**.

**Competition Events**

Estonia and Ireland are invited to participate in all competitions except for 50m 3x40 where participation is possible only if enough ranges are available. According to NSR Council decision in Stockholm June 09-10 2007:

**Finals.** *Only Nordic Shooting Region participants will be invited to attend the Finals, due to range constraints. It was agreed that Diplomas would be issued to the top three in Qualifications, regardless of nation.*

**Qualification.** *Non Member nations can only be invited to participate in an event if there is no elimination in that event.*

**PLEASE NOTE – that any use of steel pellets at the shotgun range is prohibited.**

Training rounds for Shotgun will be available for sale, 5 € per round to be paid in cash at the shooting range. There is also available RC 4 and Fiocchi cartridges at shotgun range with price of 8,5 € per box (25 pieces).

**There is a possibility to enter a B team in the shotgun events (see the General Rules for the Nordic Junior Shooting Championships 9.2).** According to 9.2 the B teams compete on equal terms.

### **Awards**

Awarding ceremonies will take place every evening at Sport Institute of Finland.

Nordic Shooting Region special medals will be awarded to the Champion (gold), the shooter who places second (silver) and the shooter who places third (bronze) in each event in the programme. Medals are awarded to individual shooters only if a minimum of six shooters participate.

The winning team in each event will be awarded gold medals, one medal to each member of the team. None is issued to teams if there were two or less teams competing. (Gen. Rules 13.1-13.3)

### **Flags**

All nations are asked to bring 2 flags in the size of 1 x 1,5 meters.

## Entry Fees

100 € (euro) per person per event to be paid together with the return of Entry Form B. Late entries 150 € per person. **The entry fees must be paid together with the return of the Entry form "B" not later than 15<sup>th</sup> July 2010.**

## Payments

Payment must be transferred in Euros. Payment must cover all entry fees, accommodation, lunch and banquet. **Payments (accommodation, lunch, banquet) must be paid after our confirming of the reservation, not later than 31<sup>st</sup> July 2010.**

### **Lunch**

Lunch will be served at the shooting ranges. The lunch is about 10 - 15 Euro per day and has to be ordered in the final registration form "B". The exact price will be informed in the next bulletin.

### **Banquet**

Saturday evening a banquet will be arranged at one of restaurants of the Sport Institute of Finland. Fee per person is 27 Euro. The banquet has to be ordered in the final registration form "B".

### **Transportation**

The transportation fee from Helsinki Vantaa Airport to Vierumäki (return fee) is 30€ per person. The transportation from hotels and Vierumäki Arena to Hälvälä Shooting Center is free of charge. The rooms of the hotels in Sport Institute are located only about 150-500 m from Vierumäki Areena, so there is no need for special transportation.

### **General Assembly and other NSR meetings**

All NSR meetings will be held at Sport Institute of Finland, Vierumäki, Saturday August 28<sup>th</sup>.

### **Custom clearance**

Shooters arriving to Finland need European firearms pass.

### **Storage**

Storage of guns and ammunition is arranged at the Vierumäki Arena. There is only a small storage for ammunition at Hälvälä Shooting Center.
